EVENT NO. 5 DATA WAREHOUSING SWINDON

The fifth DAMA UK Chapter meeting will take place in Swindon and will be hosted by the MoD. The venue is the Touchbase meeting centre which is located next to J16 of the M4. For those who may require overnight accommodation the venue is next door to a Travel Inn and across the road from a Hilton hotel.

The meeting will be an all day event (timings TBC) including a buffet lunch and unlimited refreshments. Avellino are the sole sponsors of the event.

Royal Air Force Mike Jenkins is based at Wyton in Cambridgeshire. Mike was heavily involved with a Teradata pilot project which introduced a data warehouse in support of the Sea King helicopter programme. Mike will tell us about his experiences and the lessons learned from the project.

David Hebbes is a consultant with SchlumbagerSema. David was involved in a challenging data warehouse implementation within the Vehicle Inspectorate. David will tell us how the challenges were overcome to successfully implement the data warehouse and how Avellino was part of that success.

Mike Ferguson is the Managing Director of Intelligent Business Strategies Ltd in the UK. As an analyst and consultant he specialises in database systems, business intelligence, enterprise application integration, corporate and e-business portals, customer relationship management and supply chain intelligent business solutions. With over 21 years of IT experience, Mike has consulted for dozens of companies, spoken at events all over the world and written numerous articles. Formerly he was principle and co-founder of Codd and Date UK and a chief architect on the Teradata DBMS.

5th EVENT CONTINUED

Mike will present a session on Business Intelligence in the Database (tbc). This session will discuss how to exploit business intelligence (BI) in mainstream operations by integrating BI into enterprise business processes to gain a competitive advantage and to improve the effectiveness in business operations. The session will argue that there are multiple approaches to integrating BI that differ depending on the role of the user that needs to exploit it and will take an in-depth look at the technologies that support such integrations including CPM, BI web services, BI portals, enterprise information integration.

There may also be a fourth session which will be a panel discussion (similar to the one we are having on the 3rd Dec). All the speakers plus a chair (tbc). Touchbase is also next door to a Beefeater, so there will be a 'social wind down' session afterwards. It has been agreed that Avellino can give an optional perspective session after we finish for anyone who may be interested in finding out more about their product.
